Children's Directors Report

The Children's Ministry continues to make positive progress in nurturing the spiritual growth of our kids. During this period, we have seen encouraging engagement, with weekly attendance ranging from 3 to 7 children in preschool and 10 to 27 in the elementary program.

Using the Grow curriculum, the children explore biblical principles through enthusiastic worship, lessons, and interactive activities like crafts and storytelling. While the elementary program is expanding, we are still focusing on generating similar growth within the preschool group.
